FAITH FORMATION

CATECHIST

- These are dedicated volunteers who are guided by the Director of Religious Education. Teachers are needed for Preschool thru High School grades. Assistants are also teamed with teachers to help in class.
- Materials and training classes are provided to catechists by the diocese to guide our children in their faith formation.
- Faith Formation classes are held on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 to 7:45 pm.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD (CGS)

St. Francis Xavier has a wonderful faith formation program, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), starting with children as young as 3 years old. Many of you are familiar with the CGS program and have seen our prepared space. The prepared environment is a sacred place containing materials that are models of things used in the Church's worship; such as altar, sacraments, and liturgical colors. The environment also contains materials relating to the proclamation of the faith such as parables, prophecies, infancy narratives, geography of Israel and stories in the life of Christ.

The philosophy of Catechesis of The Good Shepherd is based on the conviction that God and the child are already in a relationship. The trained catechist presents "works" to the child using the mentioned materials. The child is then invited to work with the materials themselves.

CGS is divided into three levels:

- Level 1 is typically age 3-6
- Level 2 is typically age 6-9
- Level 3 is typically 9-12

Level I: The foundational image is Christ the Good Shepherd who loves His sheep and gives everything He is for them. The child comes to discover who the shepherd is and who the sheep are. The prepared environment contains hands-on materials. The trained catechist makes presentations to the child using the materials. The child is then invited to work with the materials themselves.

Level II: The relationship with God is further developed in the image of the True Vine and the introduction of the Plan of God and our role in that great plan.

Level III: Our relationship continues to grow as we dive into the scriptures and study the Plan of God in Salvation History, including timelines, hands on materials and biblical references.

YOUTH GROUP

The Youth Ministry is to guide the development of Catholic Christian values in youth, to help the youth develop a deeper appreciation of the meaning of Jesus in their lives, to foster spiritual growth, to involve the youth in reaching out to serve people in need in our community as well as provide social and recreational activities.

- All Youth in our parish, as well as young people from neighboring parishes and non-Catholics are also welcome to join in. Activities vary monthly, but include spiritual, social and service elements.
- Our Youth Group interacts with other groups at our Parish to encourage young people to participate in the life of the faith community. Activities may include: lock-ins, volleyball, basketball, conferences and retreats. There are volunteer opportunities in the community that the youth group services.
