Thus you may want to choose another program at a neighboring parish---St. John the Evangelist in Davison, Immaculate Conception in Lapeer, or any other. If you choose to register at SS. She can answer any of your questions, let you know about the fees, and send you information on registering. I am not aware of the times and dates at any other parishes.
